ABOUT THE PROJECT

Route to Roots: Sketches of Shared European Heritage Through Past and Present is a Comenius partnership project focusing on pupil participation and involving pupils (aged 10-14) of primary and lower secondary schools in Italy, Portugal, England, Poland, Cyprus and Spain.

The project focuses on the portion of shared heritage that reached the regions to which the partner schools belong, over different periods and through diverse circumstances. Singling out common elements in otherwise different landscapes and cultures and analysing what influence they have had in shaping today's societies is meant to help pupils become aware of the deeper roots linking the countries to one another and contributing to build up a common European identity.

PROJECT MEETINGS YEAR 2

CYPRUS, PAFOS 14.10.2013-19.10.2013

In October the partners visited partner school in sunny Pafos, Cyprus . Only teachers took part in the mobility. During the week teachers prepared second year of work.

Teachers had a chance to see beautiful mosaics in Pafos and discuss important issues about the project.



POLAND, KNURÓW 10.03.2014-15.03.2014

In March the fifth mobility took place.

This time also pupils from each country participated in the visit. The pupils were very pleased to meet their Polish friends with whom they had a lovely time visiting Silesia region. During the mobility partners exchanged remarks and observation about the work done so far. Moreover, the Comenius group had a chance to see the old capital city of Poland – Cracow.



PORTUGAL, SERPA 12.05.2014-17.05.2014

From 12th to the 17th May 2014 pupils and teachers spent an unforgettable week in Serpa. During the week the partners participated in different activities and had lots of things to discuss, because it was the last meeting. The partners visited the most important monuments and sights in Serpa, and Lisbon.
